



Malmsbury Cemetery Trust Occupational Health and Safety Policy

This policy of the Malmsbury Cemetery Trust recognises the importance of the health and safety of visitors, volunteers and contractors.

Trust obligations

- Make sure, so far as is reasonably practicable, that the cemetery, and the means of entering and leaving the cemetery are safe and without risks to health.
- Not recklessly engage in conduct that may place another person in danger of serious injury.
- Review any hazard/incident/accident reports and consider whether any additional measures are required for the health and safety of visitors, volunteers and contractors.

Visitors', volunteers' & contractors' obligations

- Take reasonable care for their own health and safety and of others affected by their actions.
- Not recklessly engage in conduct that may place another person in danger of serious injury.
- Comply with any directions or procedures of the Trust in relation to health and safety matters.
- Report any potential and actual hazards, incidents and accidents to the Trust.

The Trust seeks co-operation from all visitors, volunteers and contractors in realising our health and safety objectives and creating a safe environment.
